Concurrent enrollment classes are college courses taught at Prairie Seeds Academy. High schools across the state partner with Minnesota colleges and universities to offer this. It is often called College in the Schools (CIS). Classes are taught by trained PSA high school teachers.

Because it's free, students can save time and money earning college credit in high school. Studies have shown that students who take college courses when they are still in high school are more likely to graduate from college in four years with a bachelor's degree.

PSA is offering English Literature, will add CIS Calculus and CIS Writing. When students successfully pass CIS classes, they earn both high school and college credit.
