Postsecondary Enrollment Options (PSEO)

Postsecondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) is a program that allows 10th-, 11th- and 12th-grade students to earn college credit while still in high school, through enrollment in and successful completion of college-level courses.

Students interested in PSEO apply directly to the college/university of choice. School Counselors are available to assist students with the application process.

To enroll in a PSEO program at a participating college or university, students must meet the college or university entrance requirements

Students must meet with their counselor to create a graduation action plan and expectations to ensure they meet all graduation requirements through their PSEO courses. See Ms. Nelson, counselor, for more information or email beth.hajeknelson@psak12.org.

Eligibility for PSEO programs depends on a variety of factors. Colleges and universities consider GPA, rigorous courses successfully completed, MCA test scores, and other college/university assessment results. Success in PSEO depends on many factors, such as self-advocacy, time management, organization, perseverance, motivation, and academic ability for college level coursework.

Students must provide their own transportation to their PSEO courses, but transportation reimbursement may be possible for students who qualify.
